- If modern architecture deals with integrating man to his environment, the India Habitat Centre (IHC) should serve as a template for Delhi. A massive plot set in the heart of the city, is a complex of offices which range from the National Institute of Design to the Association of Automobile Manufacturers besides housing a library, a visual arts gallery, an auditorium, conference facilities, a variety of restaurants, a hotel and an outdoor theatre. The idea of IHC was to combine these various industries into a vibrant pool where corporate and cultural minds could meet.
- 2. Architect Joseph Allen Stein came to India in the fifties. He found hope and ambitions of an emerging nation with its cultural heritage and strong craft tradition, a great pull and stayed on in this country until his retirement in 1995. The Habitat Centre is one of the last buildings he created and the largest space he had to play with. The complex is made up of a number of buildings, six to seven storeys high. Between them lie small patches of garden (a Stein hallmark) and courtyards. Special Lahori brick was manufactured for the IHC facade, as the architectural team was no longer satisfied by the quality of concrete.
- An innovative feature of the building is the top two floors being twice as wide as the floors below, making the building's shadow larger than its footprint, and creating a natural umbrella that would provide shade to the people who walk by.
